This State of Emergency has been declared due to high water level of Lake Ontario threatening homes and property.


This situation threatens the public safety.

This State of Emergency will remain in effect for thirty (30) days or until rescinded by a subsequent order.

As the Chief Executive of the Village of Sodus Point, NY, I, Christian Tertinek, exercise the authority given me under Section 24 of the New York State Executive Law, to preserve the public safety and hereby render all required and available assistance vital to the security, well-being, and health of the citizens of this Municipality.

I hereby direct all departments and agencies of the Village of Sodus Point, NY to take whatever steps necessary to protect life and property, public infrastructure, and provide such emergency assistance deemed necessary.

EMERGENCY ORDER

Local Emergency Order for: Sodus Bay

I, Christian Tertinek, the Chief Executive of the Village of Sodus Point, NY, in accordance with a declaration of a State of Emergency issued on April 20, 2017, and pursuant to Section 24 of the New York State Executive Law, do hereby order that all motorized boat traffic must operate at speed only causing no wake on Sodus Bay.

This order shall take effect at 12:01 a.m. on April 20, 2017 and shall remain in effect for five (5) days unless rescinded earlier by order of the Chief Executive. This order may also be renewed in (5) five-day increments.

Failure to obey this order is a criminal offense, punishable by law under New York State Executive Law, Article 2-B.
